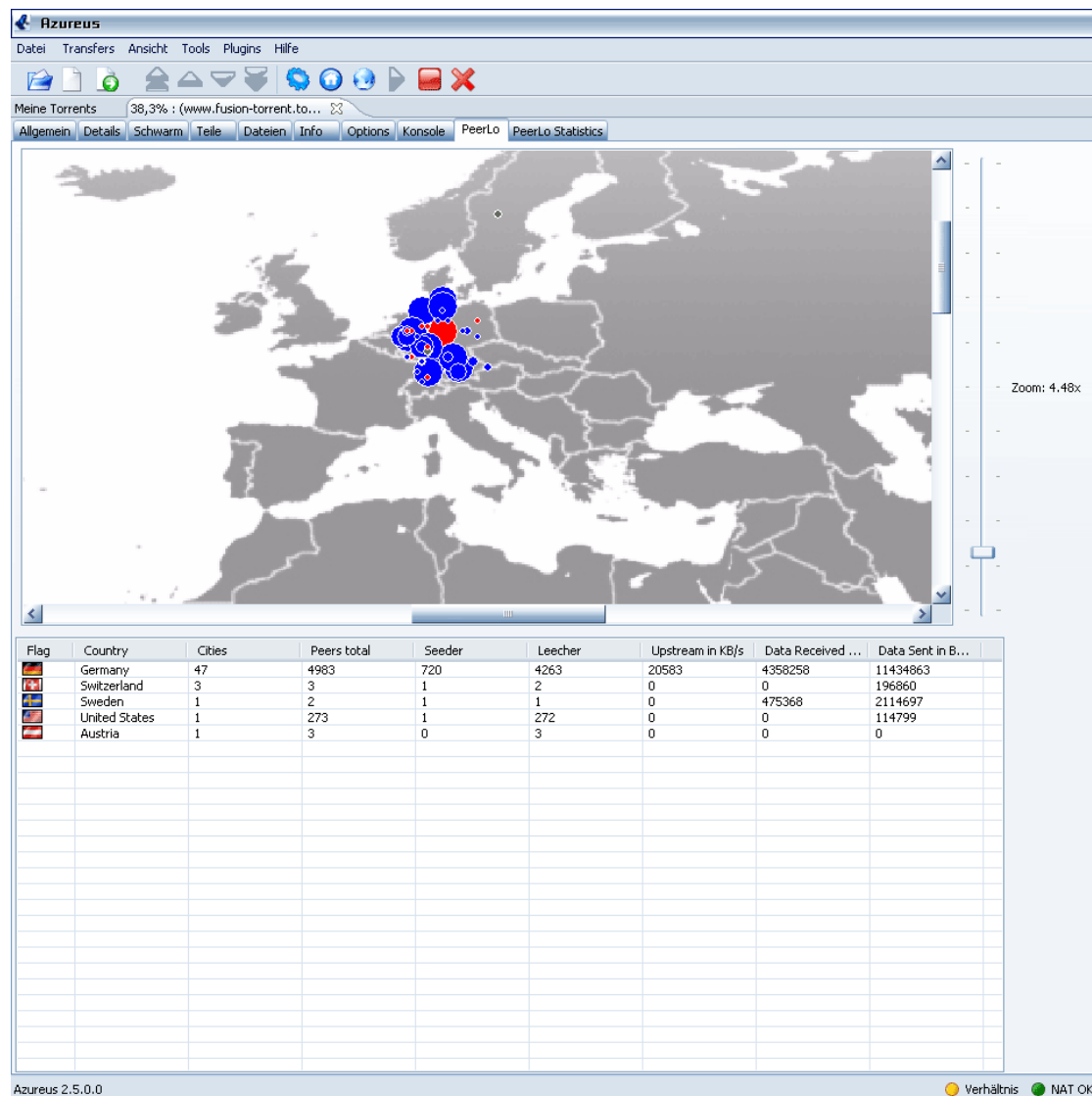
Summary

PeerLo is a plugin for the bittorrent-client "Azureus". With this plugin it is possible to visualize the swarm of a torrent you are trying to download. It allocates the IP-adresses of the swarm and visualizes them on a map. It also provides some statistics of the peers location and their downloading/uploading behavior.

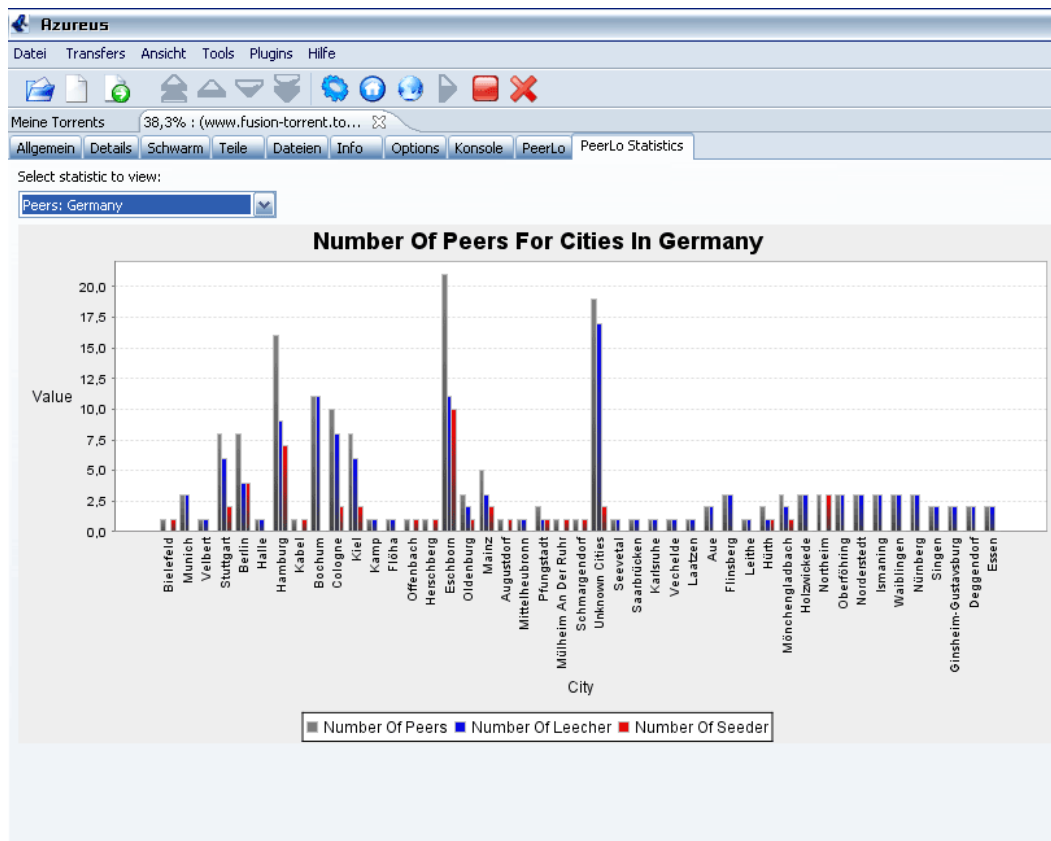

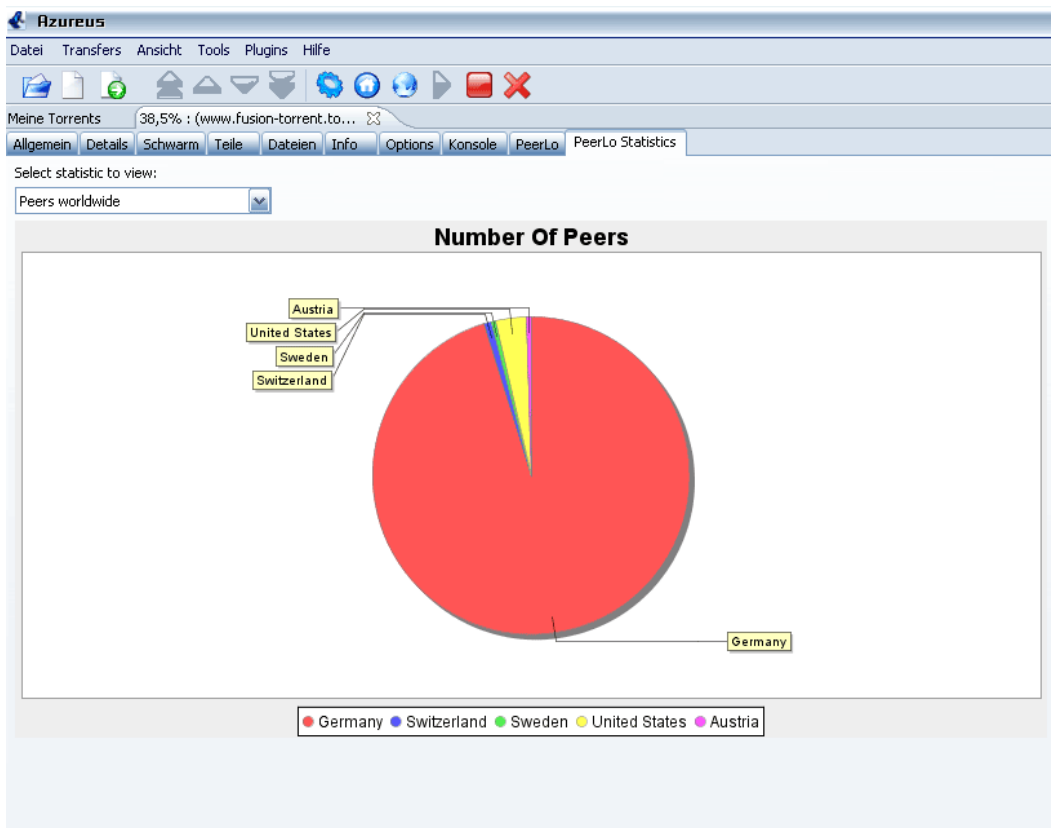
First Example: German Torrent



The Visualisation Of A German Torrent

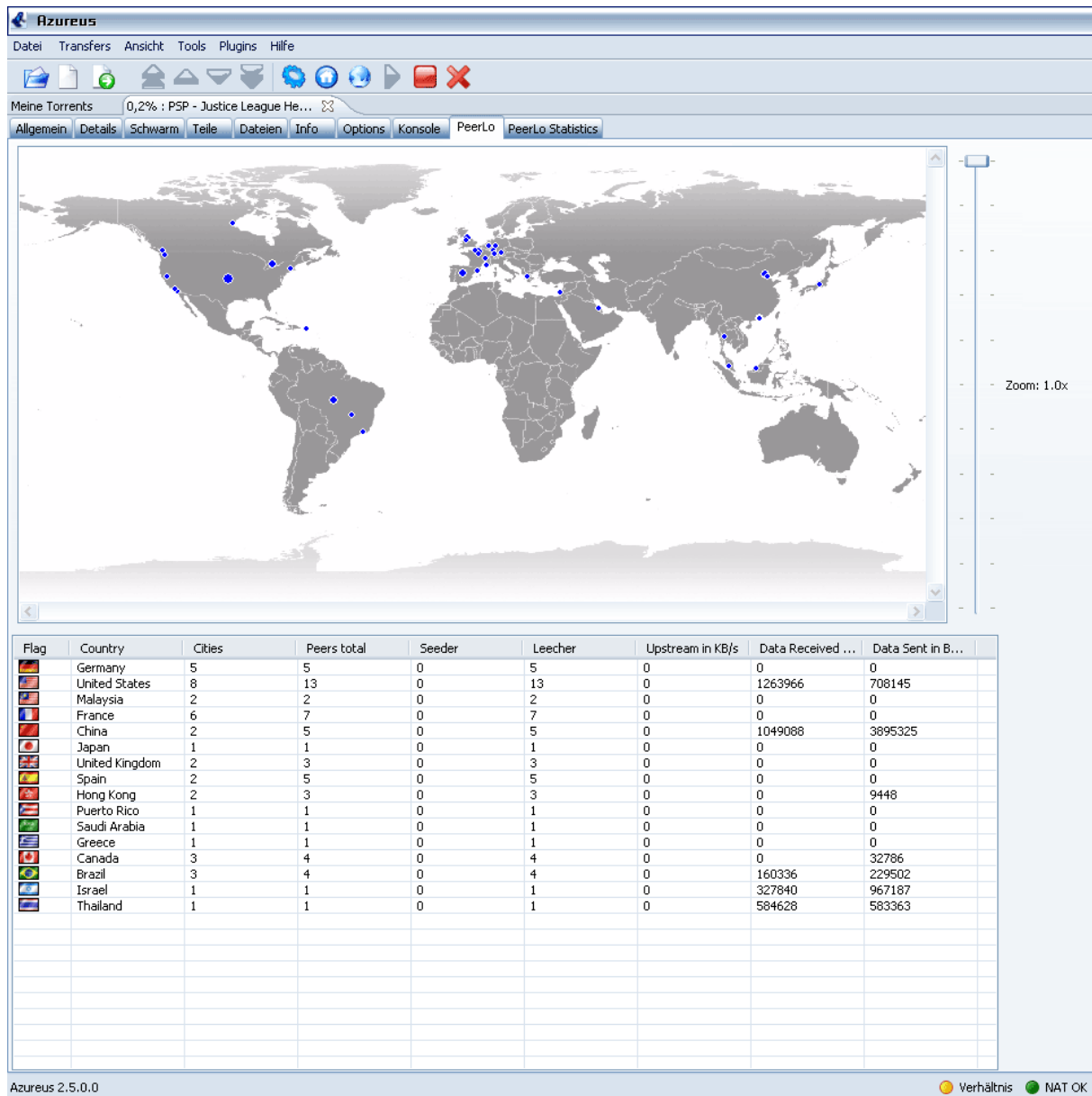


The Same Torrent In Statistics View (Peers: Germany)

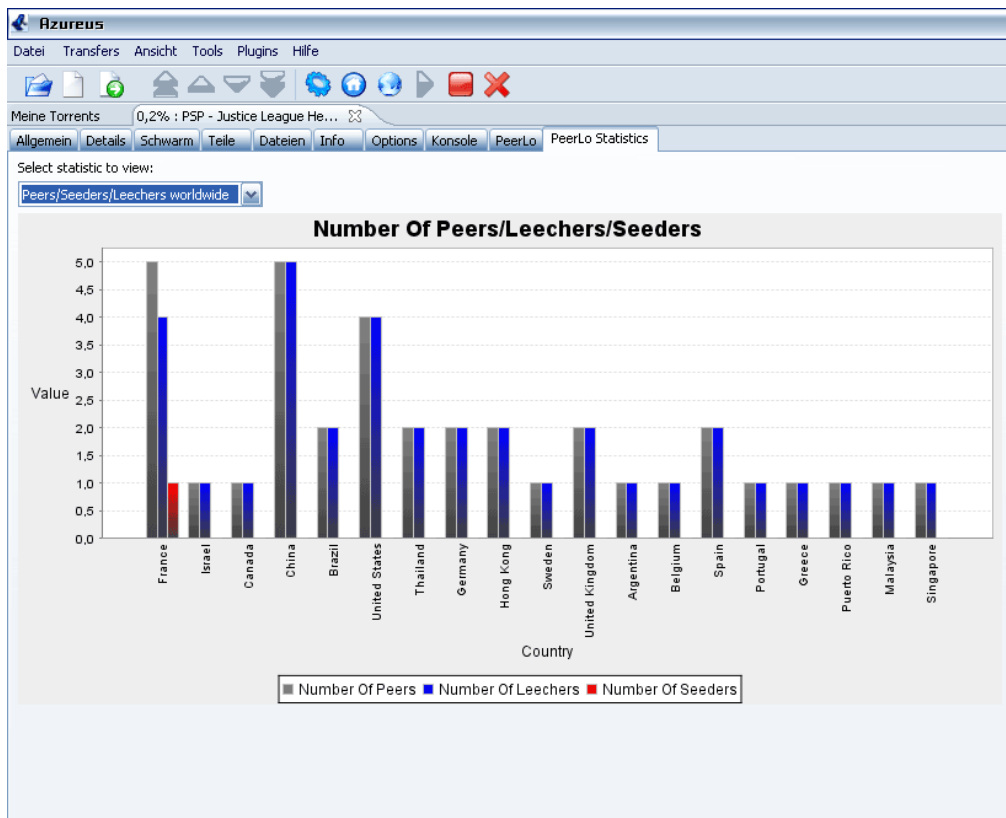


The Same Torrent In Statistics View (Peers worldwide)

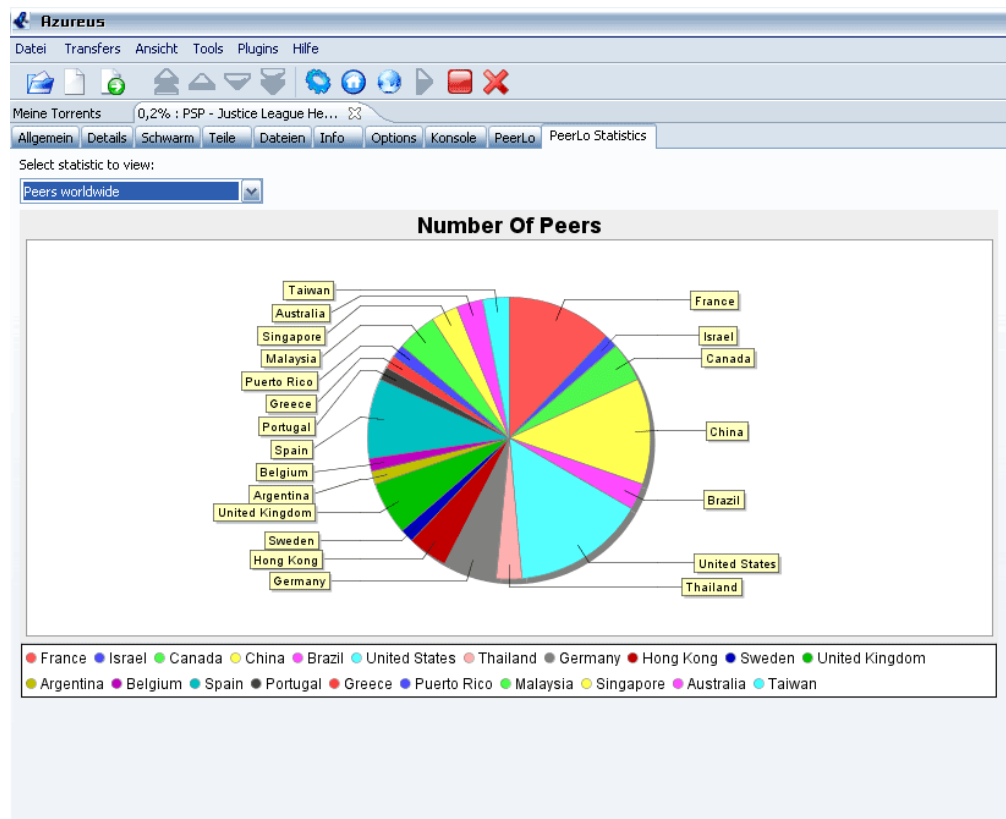
